Wall Mounted Bracket Installation








Free Standing Stand Installation

(2) The light sensor shows blue when not in use and will show green when you put your hand into.







- 2. Press this button to return to home screen.
- 3. Press MENU to organize screens and apps.
- 4. Mute. Press this button to mute the sound.
- 5. Upwards Arrow. Move up selection or move the cursor up.
- 6. Downwards Arrow. Move down selection or move the cursor down.
- 7. Leftwards Arrow. Move selection to the left or move the cursor left.
- 8. Rightwards Arrow. Move selection to the right or move the cursor right.
- 9. Confirm button. Select the use menu or setup menu, press this button to confirm.
- 10. Turn volume up.
- 11. Turn volume down.
- 12. Return to previous page or a level up in an app.



Insert the power plug into the outlet. If the Digital Signage has the switch button "I", turn it on. In power on state, press the " \oplus " button on the remote control, and the Digital Signage enters standby state.

Description of Wallpaper Switch


We suggest using a mouse to change the wallpaper.

- 5.Confirm the selection by clicking "Set wallpaper".


File Manager

Choose storage in the "Explorer" menu to read the files from different devices.




Local Settings


